DICKENS LIGHTED PARADE GUIDELINES December 1, 2012 @ 6:00 P.M.

<u>Time and Location</u>: Line-up will begin at 5:15 p.m.. All entries will be contacted with details on line-up times and locations either by phone or by email.

<u>Parade route and length of time:</u> Starting at the First United Methodist Church on Main St, the parade will turn East onto Broadway, then South onto Lansing St., then West onto Illinois, returning to the First United Methodist Church. Approximate time: 45 minutes.

Guidelines

- The organizers of this parade reserve the right to accept or reject any parade applicant.
- ALL ENTRIES <u>MUST</u> HAVE LIGHTS on them. Invertors or generators allowed.
- Parade participants must portray a holiday, children's, or whimsical theme. Have fun with it!
- No entries depicting political organizations, candidates or controversial issue will be considered.
- Parade participants MUST follow the instructions from the parade marshals and staff.
- Parade marshals and staff reserve their right to remove any unit from the parade for any reason or cause without advance notice.
- No items such as candy or other items will be thrown from any entry. Walkers along side of
 your float may HAND out candy to spectators. Walkers should be in costume and walking a
 safe distance from the float while it is in motion.
- Alcoholic beverages and other controlled substances are forbidden on and along the parade route. This includes all staging and disbands areas. Participants consuming said substances prior to or during the parade will be removed.
- All Entries <u>MUST</u> be properly identified with signs or banners with the organization's name. This is not a commercial parade-please no sales messages.
- Adults MUST be present when children are on floats. Children MUST remain seated at all times.
- Drivers of motorized vehicles <u>MUST</u> be at least 18 years of age and have a valid drivers license.
- A maximum of 20 walkers are permitted to walk with your entry. The walkers must be able to keep up with the pace and length of the parade.
- Equestrian and animal units <u>MUST</u> provide their own accompanying clean-up personnel. Horses must have the proper shoes. All vehicles, carriages, etc, <u>MUST</u> have lights on it.
- All parade participants are required to conduct themselves in such a manner as not to infringe
 on the rights of those people living in and along the staging areas and parade route.
- NO SANTA'S OR MRS. CLAUS PLEASE! One Santa will be at the end and close the parade. (No float or entry shall follow Santa!)
